The Center provides a safe, child-friendly, neutral environment for children and adolescents to be interviewed about allegations of abuse.

The Child Protection Center also provides family support services such as crisis intervention, specialized counseling, medical information and referrals to other agencies that can provide assistance. The homes tour donation will help fund an additional forensic interviewer for the center.

Metropolitan Organization to Counter Sexual Assault (MOCSA) offers a variety of treatment for those affected by child sexual abuse and assault and helps rebuild lives devastated by sexual violence. MOCSA exists to lessen the ill effects of sexual assault and abuse through prevention, inter-action, treatment and advocacy.

One of the essential treatment programs for abused children is play and art therapy. Therapists at MOCSA work with the children through their play to discover how they've been hurt, what they are feeling and how they can be helped. The homes tour donation will provide funds for the play and art therapy programs.
