

STANDING RULES
GREATER KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION
OF KAPPA KAPPA GAMMA

Revised October, 2011

1. The Association shall purchase fifty, sixty-five, and seventy-five year pins annually and shall present them to those who qualify and wish to receive them.
2. Annual dues shall be \$40, \$50 key, or \$75 golden key.
3. The names and contact information only of dues-paying members shall be included in the Blue Book.
4. Requests for information from the Blue Book from persons outside the Association shall be referred to the Association President.
5. An event shall be held annually to entertain Kansas City area collegiate members.
6. The Treasurer shall give a financial report at every meeting. The Treasurer's book shall be open to the membership.
7. The Association shall pay the Panhellenic expenses for two delegates as well as all Panhellenic fees. The Association shall pay for two delegates, the alternate delegate-elect, The Martha Galleher Cox Loyalty Recipient, the President-elect, and any Fraternity officers who are able to attend the Annual Panhellenic event.
8. An Annual allowance for the President shall be a budgeted item.
9. The Association may recognize special interest groups of the Association whose members meet regularly at times other than those set for Association meetings. The members of these groups shall abide by the By-laws and Standing Rules of the Association. They may elect their own officers, one of whom may be a representative to the Association Board. They may operate under their own Standing Rules as long as said rules are not in conflict with the By-laws and Standing Rules of the Association and the Fraternity.
10. An annual allowance for the Social Owls shall be a budgeted item.
11. The Kappa Kappa Gamma Holiday House Tour
 - a. Shall be held the first Wednesday in December.
 - b. The Holiday House Tour shall operate as a 501 (c) (3) corporation.
 - c. The President of the Association shall be a standing member of the Holiday House Tour Board.
 - d. Funds from the Kappa Kappa Gamma Holiday House Tour shall be distributed in the following manner:
 1. One fourth (1/4) of the net profits shall be distributed to the Kappa Kappa Gamma Foundation.
 2. Three fourths (3/4) of the net profits shall be distributed to Tour recipients per criteria.
 - a. Must be sponsored by a member of the Greater Kansas City, Missouri Alumnae Association of Kappa Kappa Gamma.
 - b. Must have been granted 501(c) (3) status by the deadline date for application submission.
 - c. No more than three (3) agencies (recipients) may be selected, and they must be located in the Greater Kansas City Area.
 - d. The agency must state in their application that the funds will be used in the field of rehabilitation services.

12. Holiday House Tour Proceeds Committee Recipients
 - a. Must be sponsored by a member of the Greater Kansas City, Missouri Alumnae Association of Kappa Kappa Gamma.
 - b. Must have been granted 501(c) (3) status by the deadline for application submission.
 - c. No more than three (3) agencies (recipients) may be selected, and they must be located in the Greater Kansas City area.
 - d. The agency must state in their application that the funds will be used in the field of rehabilitation services.
13. Tour Proceeds Selection and Disbursement Committee
 - a. The Committee shall be composed of five (5) members; a voting Chair appointed by the Nominating Committee, the remaining four (4) appointed by the Association President from a cross section of the Association membership.
 - b. The Tour Proceeds Selection Committee Chair must have served on the committee in the past.
 - c. The Chairman may serve only one term, but may serve again after a one year absence from Committee
 - d. The remaining four (4) members may serve only a one year term unless selected to serve as the Tour Proceeds Selection and Disbursement Committee Chair in the coming term. Members may serve again after a one year absence from the committee.
 - e. No member of the Tour Proceeds Selection and Disbursement Committee may serve as a Kappa sponsor or be a board member of an agency applying for funds.
 - f. The Committee shall recommend the Kansas City area agency (s) to receive the proceeds from the upcoming Holiday House Tour to the Association Board and the Association membership for a vote.
 - g. The Committee shall recommend the specific allocation of funds from the net profits to the agencies selected and present their recommendations to the Board.
 - h. The Association Board shall determine the allocation of funds to the Kappa Kappa Gamma Foundation.
14. Funds from the Memorial fund shall be given to the Kappa Kappa Gamma Foundation unless otherwise designated by the family of the deceased member.
15. The past records of the Greater Kansas City, Missouri Alumnae Association of Kappa Kappa Gamma shall be kept at the Western Historical Manuscript Collection at the University of Missouri Kansas City (UMKC), #302 Newcomb Hall, Kansas City, MO 64110. (816) 235-1543.
16. The Association Standing Rules may be amended by a majority vote of the Association Board present at the meeting and voting after previous notice, or by a (2/3) vote without notice.
